The Village of Streamwood was incorporated in 1957 and operates under the Council/Manager form of government. Streamwood is located approximately 33 miles northwest of the City of Chicago in Cook County and has a land area of 7.5 square miles with approximately 75 miles of streets. The population as certified by the 2005 Special Census is 39,217

The President and six Trustees compose the Village Board. They and the Village Clerk are elected at large and are representatives of the Village citizens. The President and the members of the Board compose the legislative body of the Village and enact all ordinances, determine goals and objectives and establish legislative policy. The day-to-day operations of the Village is supervised by a Village Manager who is appointed by the President and Board of Trustees to serve as Chief Administrative Officer of the Village.
